

Year 6 Homework arrangements.

Homework is given to reinforce or extend the learning in class. In the spring terms homework will focus more on revision and preparation for the SAT tests in May. Homework fosters independent learning skills and it helps prepare for transition to secondary school.

Homework must be completed in either pencil, or preferably with a *blue* roller ball pen (the kind we have in school). Biro should not be used.

It is useful if each child has a pencil case kept handy at home for homework which should include a pencil, blue roller pen, ruler, and pencil crayons. A junior dictionary and calculator may also be helpful.

Homework is always fully explained. Occasionally further help may be needed and if this is the case ask to discuss it with Mr Wilson or Mrs Bowden at lunchtime (but make sure it is on a day before it should be handed in!) Both Mr Wilson and Mrs Bowden encourage parents to discuss homework with their child, practise with them spellings and number facts, and help them understand if this proves necessary.

Mr Wilson's Literacy Set

Reading book: Read a portion of your reading book daily. Complete your Reading Journal once you have finished your book.

Spellings: New spellings on Monday, spelling test Thursday.

English homework: Homework set Friday, to be handed in by following Tuesday.

Mr Wilson's Maths Set

Maths homework: Homework set Tuesday, to be handed in by Friday.

Mrs Bowden's Literacy Set

Reading book: Read a portion of your reading book daily, preferably with an adult. Complete your Reading Journal once you have finished your book.

Reading target: One book a week.

Spellings: New spellings on Thursday, spelling test following Thursday.

English homework: Homework set Friday, to be handed in by following Tuesday.

Mr Bowden's Maths Set

Maths homework: Homework set Wednesday, to be handed in by the following Monday.

Number facts: Facts to be learned are set Friday. Test the following Tuesday.

Other homework: Occasionally homework will be set for other curriculum subjects, particularly revision for science in the weeks before the SAT tests in May. Times for handing this in will be set when each piece of homework is handed out.
